How does a contribution event work?

- 1. Sit at a round table
- 2. Find an issue together
- 3. Discuss and establish consensus
- 4. Work on remaining tasks:
 - a. Update Issue
 - b. Write patch
 - c. Add a test
 - d. Manual test
 - e. Review
 - f. RTBC

plus the Issue Queue

- Issue triage (eg. verify issues still happen) - works for simpler problems
- Test existing patches on issues (eg. with simplytest.me)
- Test experimental features, eg. the Claro admin theme that is in beta experimental stage (eg. on simplytest.me)
- Provide feedback on changes proposed based on issue screenshots or simplytest.me(eg. the new Olivero theme that is in the feedback period during DrupalCon Amsterdam)
- Work on marketing materials effort








- Navigate to the Issue Queue

Users expect rendered media, not links, and configuring the entity reference display and view mode properly is challenging new 201 comments. 1 new

Simple decimals fail to pass validation new 93 comments, 11 new

Patches not applying to 8.6.x 1 comment

Add README.txt to Bartik theme new 82 comments, 4 new

Google maps requires API keys for sites going live after 22/6/2016 new 89 comments, 1 new

- Check status (needs review or needs work), priority (not critical) and category
- Read issue summary and comments
- Add a comment to the issue letting other know that you are going to work on it
- Check with a mentor if unsure of next steps
- "Follow" the issue now appears on your dashboard

Patch creation and review

It's easier than you think!!

Write a patch:

- Download the repo
- Create a new branch
- Make and save changes
- Commit the changes
- Compare the branches
- Upload the patch, write a comment, and update the status

You don't have to know code to test a patch!!

- Test the patch
 - o Simplytest.me
 - o Locally in git repo
- Provide useful information
 - What did you test for and look at?
 - Attach screenshots
- Update the status



What tools do I need for code changes?

Local Drupal 8 environment - lots of choices

- Community sprint tools which is installing (you started earlier using Resilio sync)
- https://www.drupal.org/project/drupal choose version control and then 8.9.x version
- git clone --branch 8.9.x https://git.drupal.org/project/drupal.git

GIT for version control

git.scm.com/download

IDE

- PHPStorm (30 day trial) uses Drupal Coding Standards
- Sublime Text, NetBeans, Eclipse, Notepad ++, vim, VS Code

Introducing QuickSprint

Requirements:

- Windows 7 64-bit or higher
- MacOS Sierra (10.12) or higher
- Linux
- 6gb or more of memory

You can still contribute without these tools!

What am I downloading?

drupal.org/tools

This script will install a development environment to participate in this sprint.

It does the following:

- 1. Provide installed for Docker, git etc.
- 2. Install ddev cli helper
- 3. Copy required components to ~/Sites/sprint/
- 4. Pre-loaded docker images for the sprint toolkit:
 - a. Drupal 8
 - b. phpmyadmin
 - c. MailHog (web based mail testing)

ddev sprint - the sync is done - now what?

- Select the package file to unzip (.tar.gz for Linux/Mac, .zip for Windows)
- Install Docker from installs directory if you need it (.dmg file for Mac, .exe for Windows, package manager for linux)

- \$./start_sprint.sh
- \$ cd sprint-[date] folder
- \$./start_clean.sh
